Although born in Vienna, she lives in Villach, Carinthia, is part of a Christian free church and spends a lot of time helping people. She works in pastoral care, leads SaveOne courses and gives many free hours to an association that offers advice on abortion, supports migrants and always has an open ear for situations where quick help is required.

Protagonist | Julia Granitzer | Moderator

She is 24 years old and was adopted from Mother Theresa's home. Her childhood was difficult, but this already strengthened a sense of obligation to stand up for the little ones and the defenceless. At the age of 16, she started leading school outreaches to bring awareness to the issue and to be active as a facilitator.

She has an 8-year-old son and an 8-month-old daughter and is happily married. She became pregnant when she was 19, her adoptive mum died and her boyfriend at the time was overwhelmed. She kept her son despite the most difficult circumstances. Therefore, she is very well able to put herself in the position of women in pregnancy conflict and to encourage them to keep the child.

Timothy Hall was raised in a fourth-generation good family home. Timothy is an entrepreneur, singer, songwriter, and international speaker. He and Kristy have been married for 22 years and have 5 sons.

He extended that experience into the music business as Booking Agent and Artist Relations Manager. Following a further position as Sales Manager in industry he then moved with his family to Slovenia in 2004 and subsequently to China in 2009, working as Regional Accountant for a group of non-profit international schools. Whilst in Slovenia he established SaveOne in Europe and continued with this in China as well.
